

NAVIGATING PRAYER:

- Religious: "law is more important than love"
- Inauthentic: "check-in-the-box" way of prayer and obedience
- "Pharisaical": self-righteous
- Seeking to "appear holy"
- Prayer w/ no action
- Sees issues but not looking for solutions
- "I pray this person feel your wrath"

Self Centered

- Prayer is self-deprecating
- David's "dark night of the soul"
- Fear driven
- No knowledge of where to go
- No purpose and no will

- Prayer prioritizes God's Fatherhood & worship
- Submits to God's Kingdom, order, & will
- Sees God has given everything needed here & now
- Ministry of reconciliation: confession, repentance, forgiveness toward others
- Prayer leading to action
- Spirit-led
- Catalyst for kingdom-change

Kingdom Family Centered

- People driven but not purpose driven
- Prayer seeks approval of man's opinion
- "I pray this person will change"
- Action and service with no guidance by the Spirit
- Solutions but no power
- Prays for people, but prioritizes tradition and formula

Earth-minded


Confession & Repentance:


Leads you to true humility and forgiveness.
